<b>4.</b>	<b>Planning Applications</b> The <b>Parish Council</b> considered the amendments received in relation to the following:- <b>Ref No:</b> 2/2014/0544 <b>Proposal:</b> Erection of a bungalow <b>Location:</b> Longwood Garden Centre, Silloth <b>Applicant:</b> Mr M Orchard  The plans have hardly changed from the initial drawings submitted in August 2014. The only alteration is the removal of the dormer windows. There was already permission for a house on the site but Mark told the Council that he was going to build a single storey bungalow for his wife's parents to retire into and wanted the Council's support in having the clause changed to local residency. When the plans were received they were substantially different to what he said he was going to build. The footprint of the building is the same as the plans that were previously approved. Mr Schoular has had permission granted for a house at Parkhouse but it can't be compared to Longwood. Mr Schoular's is a private residence and this one is a business.  <b>RESOLVED</b> that the Parish Council stand by the comments made in relation to the original plans in August 2014, as the only change made to the plans is the removal of the dormer windows. The Parish Council would have no objection to a single storey bungalow which is what Mr Orchard initially proposed to build for his wife's parents to retire into.
